

# Instructions for the hearing impaired to set up a Smart Phone or Tablet in order to listen to the sound amplification system at LAKE PLACID TOWN HALL:

**You will need a WiFi enabled Smart Phone or Tablet and a set of ear buds or ear phones for your phone or tablet.  
(Apple IOS or Android devices only)**

Please follow these preliminary instructions – if you have questions, please do not hesitate to ask.

## 1. Preparation at Home:

- a. **Installing the Application:** Go to your App Store or Google Play on your Apple or Android Phone or Tablet and select and install the free app called **AudioFetch**.



The icon on the App Store or Google Play will look like this:




The installed application Icon on your phone or tablet will look like this:

## 2. Preparing to go to meeting:

- a. Make sure your battery is charged.
- b. Take your phone or Tablet to Council Meet along with your earphones or ear buds and make sure they are plugged into the appropriate jack in your phone or Tablet. **You MUST use earphones or ear buds in the meeting, and you MUST silence your phone!** (Newer iPhones may require an adapter.)

## 3. Arriving at Council Meeting:

- a. On your device, select Settings, then select WiFi, then select AudioFetchExpress as the network. Your phone may automatically connect to the free Public WiFi. If so you will have to install a WiFi Manager from Google Play that will let you select AudioFetchExpress as shown in the picture at right.



- b. You must connect to AudioFetchExpress either automatically or manually.
- c. No password is required.
- d. Make sure your earphones or ear buds are inserted in your ears.

- e. AudioFetch will look like the picture at right once it's connected. Make sure your phone isn't muted. The bar in the middle of the AudioFetch app is the volume.



- f. The system will work best if you close all other applications on your device including Bluetooth. It also works best if you use two ear buds instead of one.
